Question: How is this grant funded?

Answer: ARPA (American Rescue Plan Act) funding.

Question: I noticed that the grant guidelines have been revised from saying that customers had to be enrolled in WIOA to customers must be keyed in NCWorks.

Can you clarify what the keying expectations are if funds are used on customers as well as required documentation to collect from customers?

Answer: The steps will be very similar to the current ARPA Reentry grant. Specific intake questions and proposed services will be addressed in NCWorks online based on the selected grantee's proposed programs. Once we setup the new grant in NCWorks online, it will not take long to update keying instructions and staff privileges.
