Dental hygienists usually work as part of a team in a dentists office. They wear safety glasses, surgical masks, and gloves to protect themselves and patients from infectious diseases. When taking x-rays. they follow strict procedures to protect themselves and patients. They may spend long periods bending over to work on patients. Nationally, more than half of dental hygienists worked part time in 2012. Dentists often hire hygienists to work only a few days a week, so some hygienists work for more than one dentist.
