




Good News: Critical supply chain announcement in the region





Not So Good News: 30x30 unattainable




Not-So Good News: Suspected "manufacturing deviation" led to damaged blade at Vineyard Wind project off Massachusetts





Dear Commissioners,

As chair and on behalf of the North Carolina Taskforce for Offshore Wind Economic Resource Strategies ("NC TOWERS" or "Taskforce"), I submit this Consumer Statement regarding Docket No. E-100, Sub 190. Providing increased certainty of North Carolina's path to achieving a 70% reduction in power sector carbon emissions by 2030 and carbon neutrality by 2050 will create economic opportunities for the people and businesses in our state.

North Carolina has access to an ever-increasing range of clean energy resources, including solar, storage, onshore and offshore wind. The North Carolina Utilities Commission ("Commission") has the authority to demonstrate a commitment to these clean energy resources and to a modern electric grid to ensure their full integration. Offshore wind is a reliable, zero-emissions energy resource with operating characteristics (e.g., high-capacity factor and night and daytime generation) that pair exceedingly well with solar and storage – the development of which the Commission has already directed.

The Taskforce is expressly interested in the expansion of clean energy, particularly offshore wind, as this resource has the potential to unlock significant economic investment and job creation opportunities throughout the entire State. The Taskforce and the Department of Commerce ("Commerce" or "Department") are aware that industry leaders are awaiting a final order from the Commission before they make decisions on clean energy


