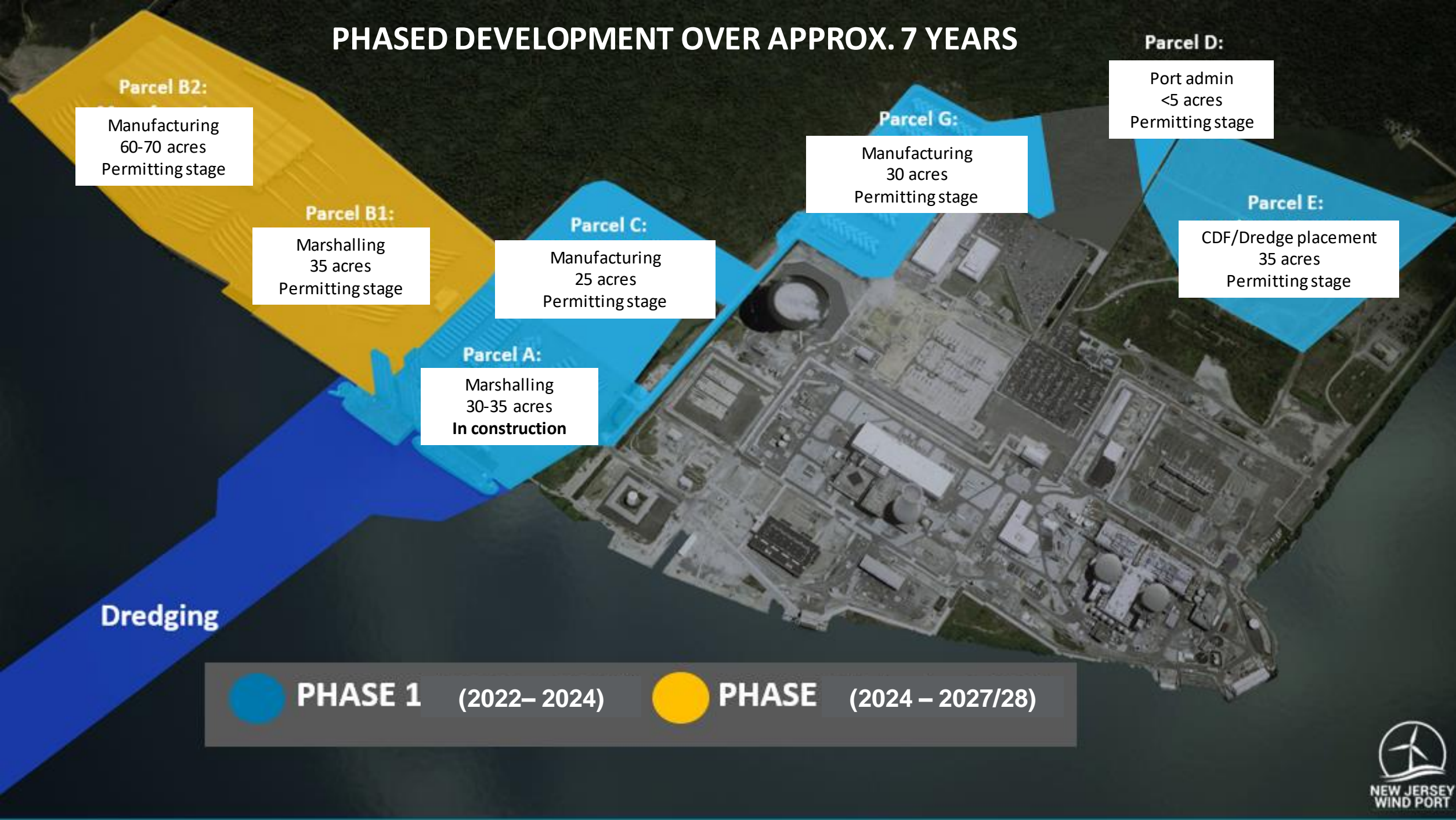
# 1<sup>st</sup> PURPOSE-BUILT OFFSHORE WIND PORT IN THE U.S.

- **Greenfield** site
- **Purpose-built** for wind
- >220-acres
- **“Co-location”** of marshalling and manufacturing
- **State** funded/financed (\$623M secured to-date)
- **>1,500 ongoing jobs**
- **>\$500M** increase to NJ’s GDP

# LEASES SIGNED WITH TWO WIND DEVELOPERS, ADDITIONAL TENANTS TO BE ANNOUNCED

- Orsted to lease 30 acres beginning 2024
- Install of 1.1GW Ocean Wind project
- Atlantic Shores to lease 35 acres beginning 2026
- Install of 1.5GW Atlantic Shores#1 project
