**Labor Force
Participation Rate**

The number of unemployed divided by those engaged members of the labor force and is **measured based on where people live, not where people work.**

Unemployed

All people who are **eligible to work** and are **currently working** or **actively looking** for work.

Modeled Estimate

Is expressed as the number in the **Labor Force** divided by the **Eligible Working Age Population.**

Labor Force

All eligible workers without a job and **actively looking** for one.

**Employment to
Population Ratio**

Is a complex calculated estimate that combines survey data, administrative statistics from the unemployment insurance system, and local demographics.

Unemployment Rate

Is another way of assessing the condition of the labor market.
