

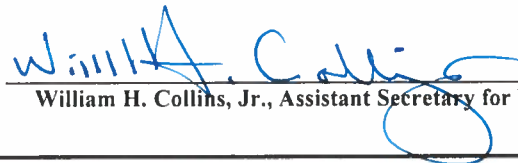

**Purpose:** To restore previously rescinded Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) Program Year (PY) 2015 Local Area funds. To rescind DWS Policy Statement Number 03-2015, Change 2, "Local Allocations with Rescissions."

**Background:** The U.S. Department of Labor released Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act Allotments for PY 2015 (July 1, 2015 – June 30, 2016) for Youth, Adult, and Dislocated Worker Activities in Training and Employment Guidance Letter (TEGL) No. 29-14, Change 3. The state allotments are based on funds appropriated to the U.S. Department of Labor by the United States Congress.

This Policy restores previously reduced PY 2015 October portion funds for the WIOA Adult and Dislocated Worker Programs shown in NC Policy Statement Number 03-2015, Change 2.

The attached charts reflect the readjustment of funds of the October portions of the Program Year 2015 Local Area Adult and Dislocated Worker allocations.

Also, included for convenience, is the original Chart for Youth allocations, which has remained unchanged.

**Action:** The attached allocation charts are to be used for planning and operating local Program Year 2015 Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act programs under the PY 2015 Local Area Plans. Funds will be administered through the Workforce Information System Enterprise (WISE) system.
