

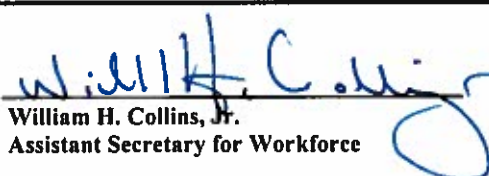

**Subject: Local Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA)
Workforce Development Program Year 2017 Allocations**

Purpose: To transmit Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) Program Year (PY) 2017 Local Area Allocations.

Background: The U.S. Department of Labor released Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act Allotments for PY 2017 (July 1, 2017 - June 30, 2018) for Youth, Adult, and Dislocated Worker Activities in Training and Employment Guidance Letter (TEGL) No. 27-16. The state allotments are based on funds appropriated to the U.S. Department of Labor by the United States Congress through the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2017.

According to the Act, youth activities funds become available for obligation in early April of each year. However, the Act funds the WIOA Adult and Dislocated Worker programs in two separate appropriations. The first becomes available for obligation on July 1, 2017; this portion is commonly referred to as the "base" funds. The second becomes available for obligation in October 1, 2017; this portion is commonly referred to as "advance" funds because they are provided in the appropriations act passed during the fiscal year immediately before the fiscal year when the funds are available.

The attached charts provide the July and October portions of the Program Year 2017 Local Area Adult and Dislocated Worker allocations and the full Youth allocation.

Action: The attached allocation charts are to be used for planning and operating Program Year 2017 Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act programs under the PY 2017 Local Area Plans.

Local Workforce Development Boards will be administered the "base" funds through the Workforce Information System Enterprise (WISE) system when received by the Division.
